The next election for offices of Commissioners to sit on the Navigation and Canal Commission of the Aransas County Navigation District (the District) will be held on Tuesday November 8, 2022. The offices to be voted on are Commissioner Precinct 2, Commissioner Precinct 4 – 4A, and Commissioner At Large.

The District is a political subdivision of the State of Texas. Its territory has the same boundaries the County of Aransas. The precincts from which the District's Commissioners are elected have the same boundaries as the precincts from which Aransas County Commissioners are elected. The District's Commissioner At Large is elected from the entire territory of the District.

Persons may apply to be a candidate on the ballot for one of these office by filing an application with the Secretary of the District's Commission. The first day to file will be July 23, 2022 and the last day to file will be August 26, 2022. An application filed before the first day or after the last day will be rejected. Applications must be addressed to the Commission Secretary and be delivered to the District office at 911 Navigation Circle, Rockport, Texas, 78382 or an application may be filed through e-mail transmission of the completed application in a scanned format to the following e-mail address: www.acnd.org.

A candidate for office of Commissioner must meet the following requirements no later than August 26, 2022 (or as of an earlier date on which the Candidate swears to the Application):

- Be at least eighteen (18) years of age;
- Be an elector of the county, i.e. be registered to vote in Aransas County;
- Have resided continuously in the State of Texas for at least 12 months;
- Have resided continuously within the territory for which the candidate is running for at least 6 months;
- Be not otherwise disqualified by the Texas Election Code or other Texas law.

District elections are non-partisan; a person's candidacy may not be associated with a political party.

The polling place for the election will be held at the Aransas County Elections & Voter Registration Office, located at 602 E. Concho Street, Rockport, Texas. In addition, there will be places and times for early voting, not yet determined. The election will be administered by Aransas County, acting under

contract with the District. For more and current details about times and place for voting, please also refer to the County's election website:
